



CRITICAL FRIEND LEVEL 2 VOLUNTEER - Role Description

Are you passionate about Australia's National Icon? Do you want to actively participate in being a catalyst for change for the koala? We need you!

This is an exciting volunteer role and is designed to provide support services to the Koala Smart teachers, while working remotely from home or a space of your choice.

To ensure the students and teachers get the most out of the program, Critical Friends, assist teachers with their koala smart journey and connect teachers with appropriate people in the conservation field for excursions, incursions or for student project support (contacts provided to volunteer) and go into the classroom to provide . Additional tasks may include answering emails, giving virtual or in person tours of the Koala Smart website, phone calls, visiting schools to support participation in Koala Smart, and nurturing a relationship with the teacher. This role is the most advanced educational volunteer position and volunteers are trained to deliver lesson plans for teachers (upon request). This will strongly support our busy teachers and allow for many more opportunities for Koala Smart to be integrated into schools.

Please note that previous knowledge of koala conservation or natural history is not required. You will be provided with all the required training to excel in the role.

Responsibilities

- Help teachers navigate Koala Smart over the phone, internet or in person
- Connect teachers with appropriate experts if required (contacts provided)
- Understand the structure of lesson plans and website and inform educators
- Motivate students on their projects ideas and advise if appropriate
- Go into classrooms and present Koala Smart Lesson Plans (if requested)
- Log your volunteer hours
- Promote Koala Smart
- Respond to emails and phone calls
- Attend online meetings as requested
- Provide exceptional customer service
- Fill in reports as required

Requirements and skills

- Be over 18
- Hold a current Working with Children Check (free for volunteers)
- Be willing to learn and develop new skills
- Passionate about Koala Conservation
- Tech savvy is a plus but not required
- Be willing to gain familiarity with navigating Koala Smart's website
- Experience with word-processing software and spreadsheets (e.g., MS Office) or willingness to learn
- Knowledge of online calendars and scheduling (e.g., Google Calendar) or willingness to learn
- Excellent phone, email, messaging, and communication skills
- Experience in working with a diverse demographic of individuals is desirable
